## Help us define long-term R&I priorities and implement them in the most efficient way

### Objective

The objective of this workshop is to consult wind energy R&I experts to define and discuss how to implement long-term research and innovation priorities for the wind energy sector. The discussion will build on the already established ETIPWind Strategic Research and Innovation Agenda (SRIA) 2025-2027 and the EERA's long-term research programme. The workshop will focus on how to safeguard and enhance the EU's technological leadership in wind energy and ensure that identified R&I priorities are effectively addressed at the EU and at the national levels. Participants will identify strategies for effective implementation of the R&I agenda and discuss with the European Commission on how to improve the current EU funding framework for wind energy.

### Format

The workshop will be a mix of thematic presentations and interactive discussions, facilitated by questions to the audience and the online tool Slido to gather input from online participants.

### Expected Outcomes

- Validation and potential refinement of the long-term R&I topics identified by the wind R&I community
- Strategic insights on how to effectively address and implement these R&I priorities at the EU and national levels
- An action plan on the next steps for safeguarding EU leadership in wind energy thanks to R&I, including recommendations for policy, R&I funding, and industry-academia collaboration.
